CANCELLATION NOTICE

This tariff cancels in whole or in part, as the case may be, all Class "B" tariffs effective prior to June 1, 1998, which provided rates and charges for the transportation of passengers to the extent outlined in Item 5 herein.

---

PARTICIPATING CARRIERS

This tariff applies for account of all carriers holding authority under Class "B" Certificates to transport passengers as described in Item 5.

---

ITEM 5

APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This tariff applies only on passengers transported in limousines

"LIMOUSINE" means any motor vehicle that meets the manufacturer's specifications for a luxury limousine with a designed seating capacity for no more than ten passengers and with a minimum of five seats located behind the operator of the vehicle, and which does not have a door at the rear of the vehicle designed to allow passenger entry or exit; further, no vehicle shall be permitted to be operated both as a taxicab and a limousine.

RATES AND CHARGES

RATES AND CHARGES IN THIS TARIFF ARE MAXIMUM RATES AND CHARGES AND MAY NOT BE EXCEEDED. Subject passengers may be transported at rates and charges lower than those shown herein subject to prior arrangements between the passenger and the limousine carrier.

ITEM 15

REVISION OR CANCELLATION OF TARIFF PROVISIONS

Revision or cancellation of tariff provisions will be made by the issuance of Supplements to the original tariff numbered consecutively starting with Supplement No. 1. When an Item is brought forward in a Supplement and revised, the Item will have the next consecutive letter suffix added to it and will cancel the previous item of the same number. For example, Item 20-A will cancel Item 20; Item 20-B will cancel Item 20-A.

ITEM 20

CLAIMS

LIABILITY:

1. The carrier will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, bad weather conditions or roads, now storms and other conditions beyond its control and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. The company will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by its agent or employees, but same is not guaranteed.
2. If any conditions beyond the carrier's control make it, in the opinion of the carrier inadvisable to operate "Charter Coaches", either from the "Place of Origin" or any point en-route, the carrier shall not be liable therefor.
3. All claims for damage of whatever character must be filed in writing within nine (9) months at the nearest office or agency of the carrier.

ITEM 25

HOLIDAYS

Holidays are defined as New Years Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Easter, Memorial Day and Christmas Day.

ITEM 30

MINIMUM CHARGES

Charter minimum charges per vehicle cannot exceed 3 hours except as follows:

Proms	- Minimum Charges cannot exceed 4 hours
New Years Eve & New Years Day	- Minimum Charges cannot exceed 6 hours
Super Bowl	- Minimum Charges cannot exceed 12 hours

ITEM 35

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Payment may be made by cash, credit card or direct billing. Personal checks for deposits only. All personal checks must reach the company 15 days before trip. There is a \$20.00 fee for all returned checks. Cash is accepted for payment of trip. Billing is only for approved corporate clients when satisfactory arrangements have been made with the carrier.

Cancellations – Except on airport transfers, 48-hour notice is required for all cancellations or a minimum charge will be applied.

ITEM 40

DEFINITION OF VEHICLES

Charter or Private Car	– Means exclusive use of vehicle.
Shared Vehicles	– Carrier reserves the right to put additional passengers in car as volume requires.

ITEM 45

DAMAGE TO VEHICLES

Each vehicle assigned to Charter Service will be in good condition, including the condition of window glass and seats. Any damage to the vehicle caused by the renting party will be charged by the carrier to the renting party.

---

ITEM 50

OBJECTIONABLE PERSONS

The carrier reserves the right to refuse to transport any person who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, or who is incapable of taking care of himself or herself, etc., or who shows conduct which is such, or is likely to be such, as to make him or her objectionable to other passengers.

**EXCEPTION:** This rule does not apply to persons who are ill and accompanied by an attendant or nurse.

ITEM 55

GRATUITIES

“A gratuity is a voluntary payment by the passenger(s) to the carrier apart from the tariff rate. Such payment(s) are strictly voluntary. Acceptance of such voluntary payments by the carrier shall not violate the provisions of O.C.G.A. §46-7-19.”

ITEM 60

CHARTER TIME CHARGES

(6) Passenger Limos	- \$75.00 per hour
(8) Passenger Limos	- \$90.00 per hour
(10) Passenger Limos	- \$110.00 per hour

Note A: The minimum charge per vehicle cannot exceed 3 hours except as follows:

Proms	- Minimum Charges cannot exceed 4 hours.
New Years Eve and New Years Day	- Minimum Charges cannot exceed 6 hours.
Super Bowl	- Minimum Charges cannot exceed 12 hours.

Carrier may require a non-refundable deposit up to but not exceeding the charge for one hour of service. Such deposit will apply toward the payment of any other applicable charges.

ITEM 65

AIRPORT RATES & CHARGES

All airport rates and charges, exclusive of accessorial charges as shown in Item 70 or costs passed through to the customer such as sales tax, parking fees, or tolls in connection with airport trips, can be no more than the rates in Item 60 above.

ITEM 70

ACCESSORIAL CHARGES OR ADVANCED CHARGES

Gate Fee	- Not to exceed \$25.00
Customs Fee	- Not to exceed \$40.00

Charges that are advanced by the carrier such as sales tax, parking fees, toll, or other additional services requested by clients may be billed to the clients at the actual cost.

WAITING TIME

Airport transfers are subject to the following waiting time:

First 15 minutes	- Free
Next 15 minutes or fraction thereof	- \$10.00
Next 15 minutes or fraction thereof	- \$10.00

After 45 minutes, the charge will be for 2 hours minimum.
